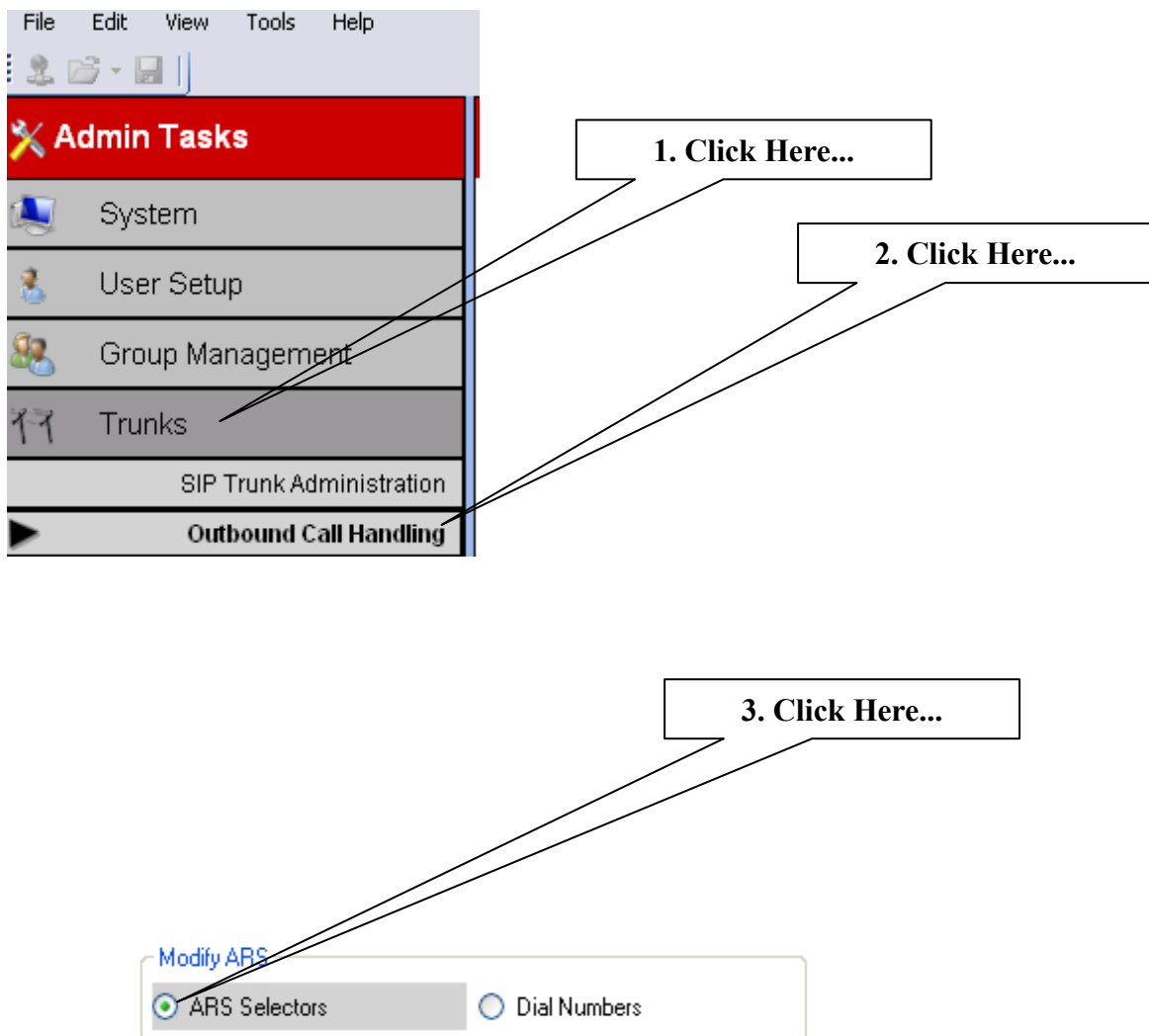

Add Analog CO Line

Notes: Dialing 865 on the Intercom will access CO Line 4.

Selector 65 (aka: 865 / aka: 9) is the default selector.

Any lines assigned here will be accessed by dialing 9 or 865.

Selector 68 (aka: 868) is also a selector code.

Any line assigned here will be accessed by dialing 865.

There are 31 available Selectors (68 through 99 , aka; 868 through 899) but there are only 6 “Dial Numbers Tables”.

You can also assign “Pool Buttons” to directly access Outside Lines that are pooled together.
