Usually the same as the SIP Telephone Number

Account Password

Each Channel gets its own CO Line Position and ONLY uses 1 SIP Trunk Channel License during a conversation.

### Channel Setup

Indicates the CO Line Position in the KSU  
and is also used to place a CO Line Appearance on the phones

In most cases this will be the same as the Authentication Name.  
It MUST be entered for each Channel

Note : Local URI will need to be configured to make and receive calls on a channel.

**Remember, you need a minimum of 3 pieces of information to Register to a Service Provider:**

- The IP Address or URL of the Service Provider
- Your Account Number (usually your telephone number)
- Your Password

**Registration tells the Service Provider**

- Who you are
- Where you are
- That you are allowed to use this service
