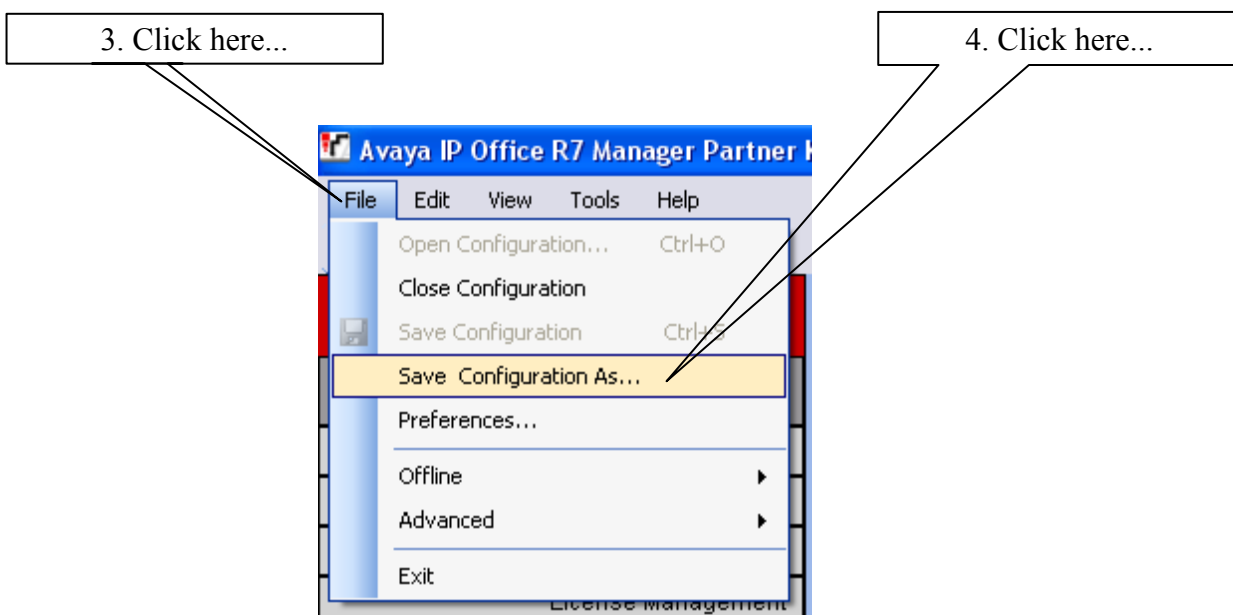
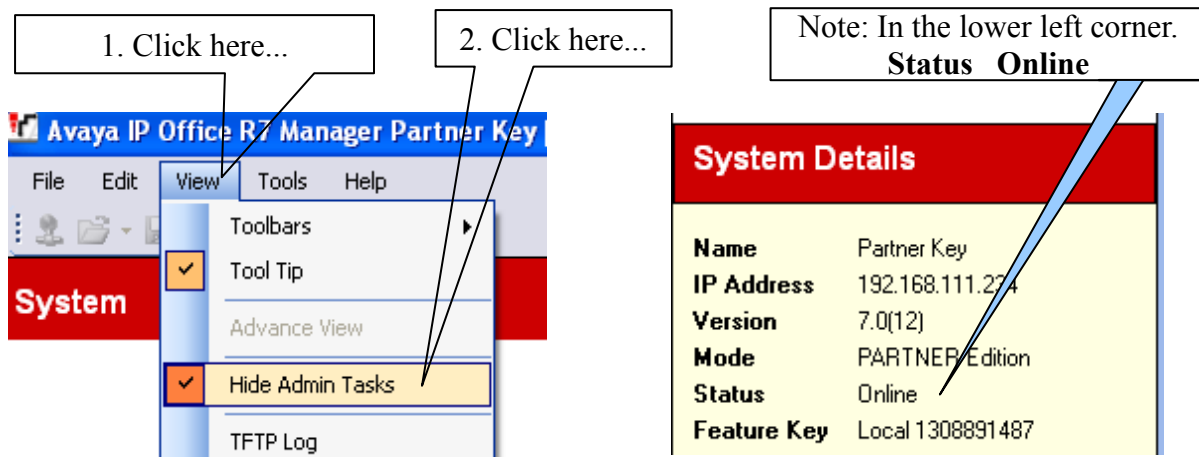
## <<< Save Configuration >>>

This Help Sheet explains how to Save a configuration and how to Send it to a KSU.

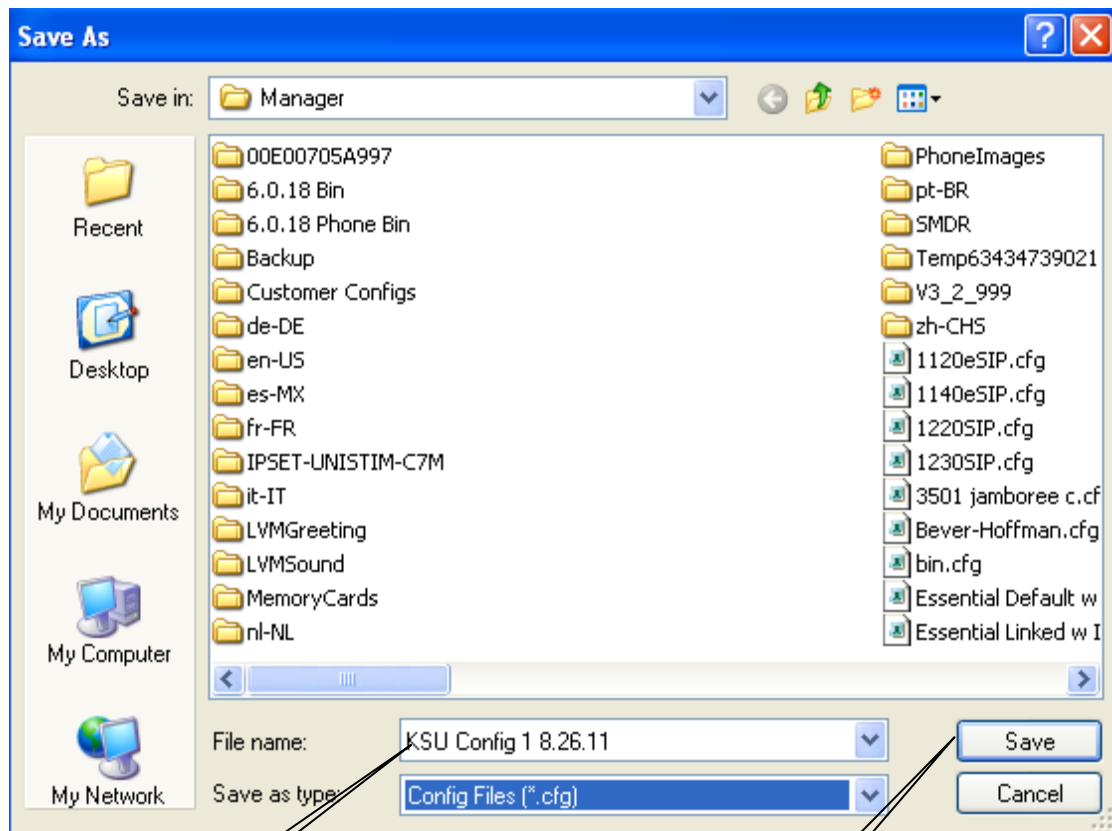
It is very similar for both IP Office Partner and Essential.

I have already Opened the Configuration from the KSU.

I am using Windows XP and working with an IP Office Partner, your views may look different.



You will see this box pop up



5. Enter a name for the configuration...

6. Click here to Save it...

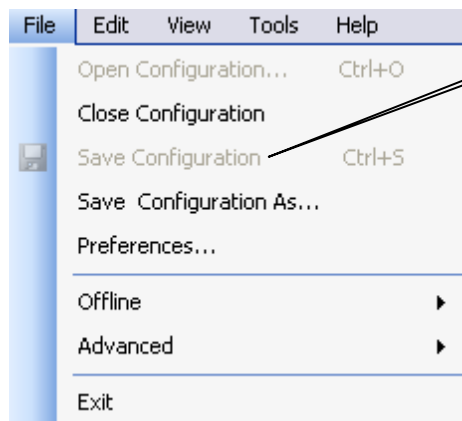
The configuration will now be saved in your computer with the name you gave it.

The screen will clear and then return with the configuration.

**Special Note:**

**When the configuration returns to the screen, any changes that you make are only going to be made in your computer and can not be sent (Merge or Immediate) to the KSU.**

**If you click on File you will see that “Save Configuration” is grayed out.**

**Close Configuration and then Open Configuration again and you will be able to send any additional changes to the KSU.**






4. Select the KSU to receive the configuration...

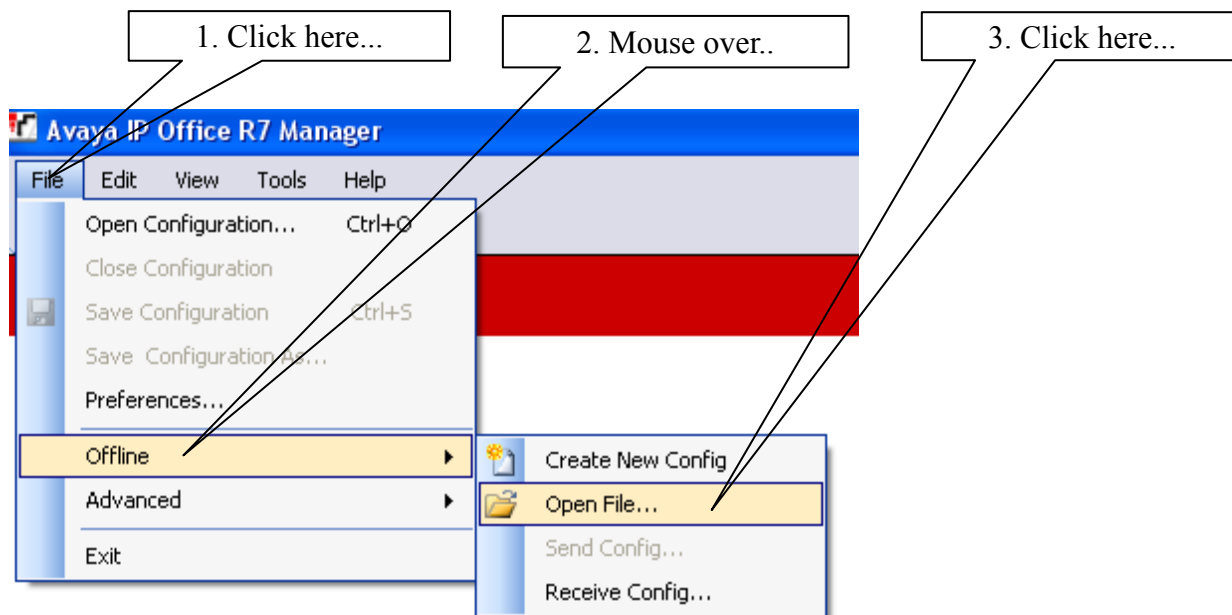
