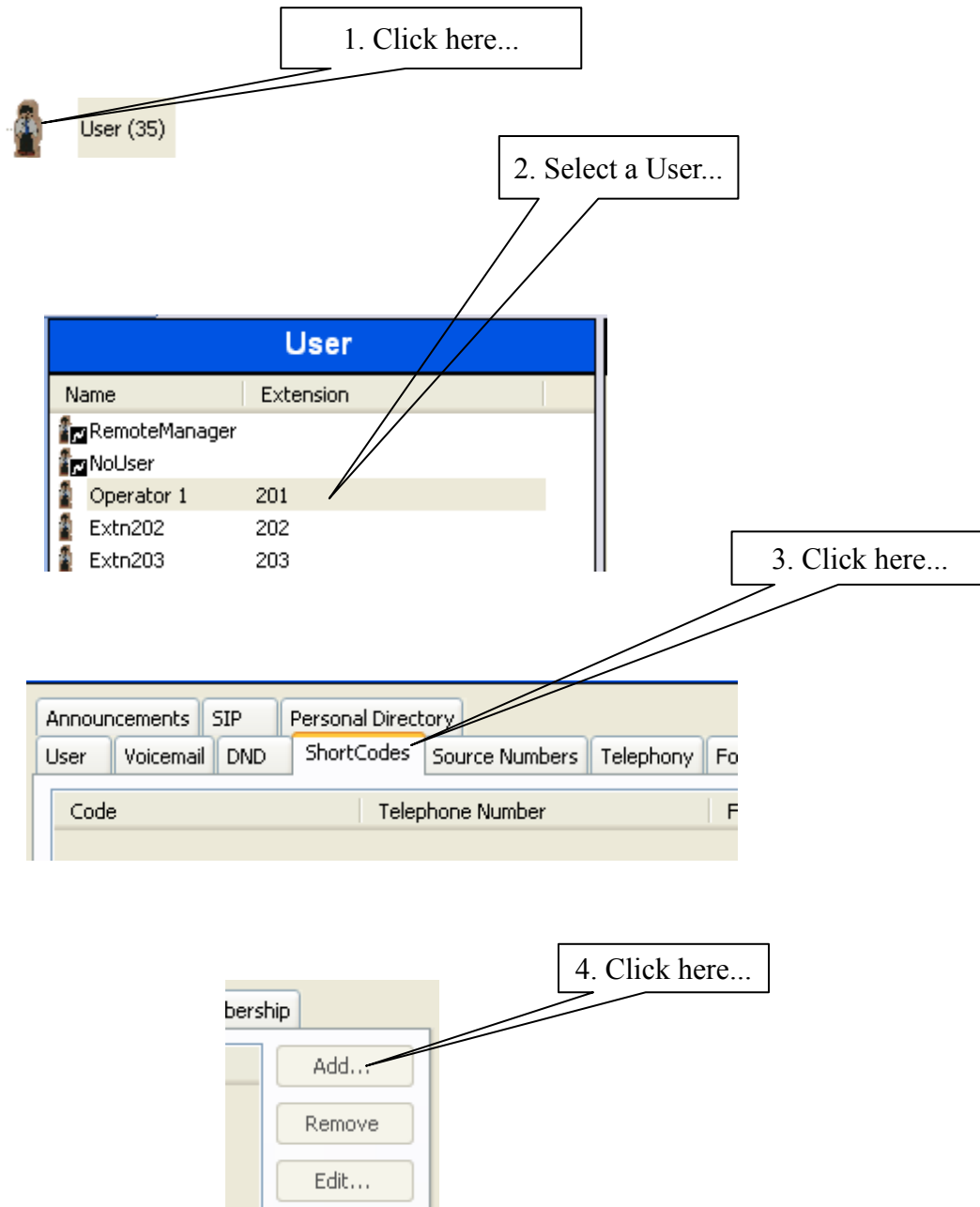


Avaya IP Office Essential Edition Extension to Send a Specific CID with PRI & SIP Telquest Tech Support

Note:

Your PRI or SIP service provider will usually only allow you to send numbers they have issued to you.

These will be your DID Numbers.

If you try to send a number that is not yours, the call will fail and you will hear a steady tone.
