

Here is how to place a Private Line on a phone and make it ring.


In this example, we will be placing Line 4 on Button 4 of Extn 202.




Getting the phone to ring... Step 1...

Note:

Remember that the IP Office Essential is a PBX not a Key System.

It was not designed to have all lines on all phones.

It does provide a means to assign Direct Outside Lines to buttons mainly for Private Lines.

In some cases you may find that the Private Line may not ring if it is positioned before the three Appearance buttons.

Example: The Private Line may not ring when set similar to this...
