

This Help Sheet explains how to Save a configuration and how to Send it to a KSU.


It is very similar for both IP Office Partner and Essential systems.

The configuration will now be saved in your computer with the name you gave it.



3. Click here...



5. Continue with password and follow the additional prompts on the screen to complete the process.




