This Help Sheet explains how to program a Hotline Dialer that will call "Extension B" when you pick up the handset on "Extension A".

Do this on the Originating extension, "Extension A" Set the amount of time that passes until the Hot Line Dialler starts dialing. The setting below is set to 2 seconds.
