

Panasonic NS-700 Emergency Dial Alert Telquest Tech Support

When any extension dials an Emergency Number like 911, a alert message can be played to selected extensions.

In the example below, 2015551234 and 5551234 have been added as Emergency Numbers. These represent a local police or fire department numbers that could be dialed. 911 is also an Emergency Number, but does not need to be entered.


Extensions assigned as Manager in Class of Service can have a System Alarm button on their phone.

Here we will assign Manager to COS 1.


By default, all Digital telephones are assigned to COS 1.

That means that all extensions can have a System Alarm button.

If you only want certain phones to have the System Alert button, use a different COS.



Assign a System Alarm button



All phones in the selected Conference Group (Page 1, Step 6) will receive the Alert Notification (Page 1, Step 7) whenever an Emergency Number is dialed.

The Alert Notification will play via the speakerphone over and over until it is answered.

If the phone has a System Alarm button, it will flash.


Only the phones with a System Alarm button will be able to see which extension dialed the emergency number by pressing it.

To clear the System Alarm button, press it and then press the CLEAR button below the LCD.

Email Notification for Emergency Calls

Emails can be sent whenever an Emergency Number is dialed.

Setting an Email account in the NS-700 is not covered in this Help Sheet.



6. This will appear as the Title of the received Email. It will be followed by a # and the Extension number that dialed the Emergency Number.

Example of the default Title where Extension 123 made the call: Emergency dial alert #123

You can change it if you want to but, the # and Extension Number will still be added.
