

Panasonic NS-700 Remote Programming Internet Access Info Telquest Tech Support

Starting with Version 6.01 and higher, you **MUST** use a complex password if you want to program the system remotely.

Here is Panasonic's statement: (paraphrased)

Remote Maintenance using LAN and Port Forwarding

The password **MUST** follow **ALL** of the following four conditions:

It **MUST** contain three different **capital letters** from A to Z

It **MUST** contain three different **lower case letters** from a to z

It **MUST** contain two **different numbers** from 0 to 9

It **DOES NOT** contain the sequence of "ABC", "abc" or "1234"

Here is are examples of good Passwords:

AHTksu70, JYTdke93, GTWxpo53

In each good password there are:

3 different capital letters, 3 different lower case letters and 2 different numbers.

Here is an example of bad Passwords:

ABCwer125 Contains ABC

AURabc357 Contains abc

ASWswr1234 Contains 1234
