

Panasonic KX-NS700 Telephone System Remote Connection for Programming Telquest Tech Support

You can use a web browser to connect and program the KX-NS700 Telephone System

The KSU listens for connections on Port 80

You will need to have Port 80 in the Network Router that the KSU is connected Opened to the LAN IP Address of the KSU.

To connect to the KSU from a remote location:

Open a web browser

Enter the Public IP Address of the location where the KSU is located with **/WebMC/users/login** at the end

Example: Where 121.202.33.141 is the Public IP Address

[Http://121.202.33.141/WebMC/users/login](http://121.202.33.141/WebMC/users/login)

You can also use a different port.

Lets say 22334 (TCP) as an example.

Just have port 22334 (TCP) Forwarded in the Router to the LAN IP Address of the KSU using Port 80.

Example: Where 121.202.33.141 is the Public IP Address
