It will then allow you to listen to your messages.

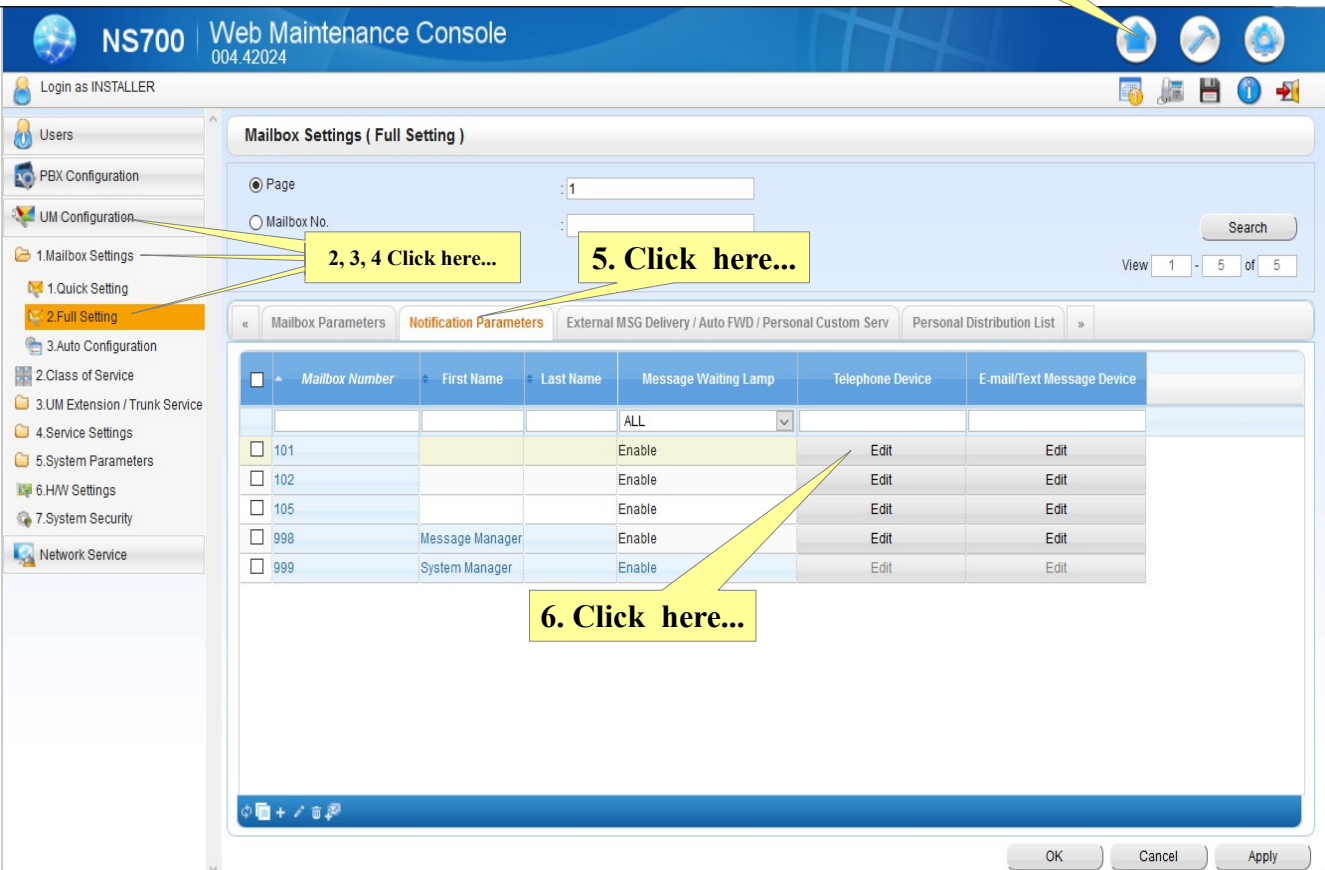
